### OUTDOOR ADVENTURE ACTIVITIES AT MARRICK PRIORY

Pupils have really enjoyed taking part in a range of activities with Marrick Priory Outdoor Centre this week.



Year 1 and 2 visited the centre on Tuesday, trying archery, climbing and team challenges. Pupils gave us some great feedback:

“My favourite part of Marrick Priory was rock climbing.”
