
SWALEDALE FESTIVAL

STAFFING FOR THE YEAR AHEAD

In recent weeks we have finalised staffing plans for the year ahead and are pleased to share them with you below. There is much continuity from the arrangements this year; we find that this benefits pupils in September as they settle back in to familiar routines with teachers that they often already know. Also, staff know how to best support pupils with their learning, ensuring great progress in the autumn term.

In the Early Years class, Mrs Walker and Mrs Stainsby will continue to lead, supported by Mr Reed, Miss Bell and Mrs Tranter. Mrs Walker will teach on Monday, Tuesday, Wednesday morning and Thursday each week. Mrs Stainsby will teach on Wednesday afternoon and Friday each week.

Following a very successful year with us, Miss Fawcett will continue to teach KS1. Mrs Allison will support the class on Monday morning each week.

KS2 pupils will continue to be taught by literacy and numeracy specialists each morning. Mrs Bastow will deliver literacy for Y5/6 pupils before morning break, and for Y3/4 pupils after break. Miss Dinsdale and I will teach numeracy before morning break and Y5/6 pupils after break.

Mrs Bastow will teach Y3/4 pupils each afternoon, apart from Wednesdays when Mrs Allison will take over, teaching RE and Music. Mrs Atkinson will support Y3/4 pupils each day.

Miss Dinsdale will teach Y5/6 pupils each afternoon, apart from Tuesday when Mrs Allison will take over, teaching RE and Music.

We are currently recruiting a teacher to provide maternity cover for Miss Dinsdale later in the autumn term and will update you in due course.

STEPPING-UP DAYS and TRANSITION MEETINGS

We are keen to ensure that transition arrangements, which enable pupils to prepare for the next year of their schooling, are as effective as possible. This year we have again arranged two days, Monday 9th and Tuesday 10th July. Some of our current Year 6 pupils are undertaking their transition activities at secondary school on these days, and pupils in our other year groups will step-up to the class that they will be in next (school) year.

Current Nursery aged pupils moving into Reception in September will spend the two days in the EYFS class at Reeth and will join older pupils for the daily assembly after lunch. **Parents of these pupils are invited to Reeth School on Wednesday 4th July at 2:30pm, for refreshments, followed by a meeting to discuss transition to school.** Information packs for parents of Reception starters will be given out at this meeting.

Current Reception pupils will spend both days in the Y1/2 class at Reeth.

Pupils who will be in Years 3 to 6 will be based at Gunnerside. There will be a PE lesson on the Tuesday afternoon, so all pupils will need their PE kit at Gunnerside. **Parents of pupils who will be in Year 3 in September are invited to Gunnerside School at 12.45pm on Tuesday 10th July** to see pupils enjoying the end of their lunchtime session, meet with Mr Stainsby to discuss transition into Key Stage 2 and join pupils for part of their PE lesson with Mrs Bastow.

SCHOOL MEALS

As a school we value our school kitchen service which we purchase from the Local Authority, enabling us to offer freshly prepared and nutritionally balanced meals to pupils each day at both sites. The service does have a cost implication for our school, over and above the amount we charge to parents, so maximising the numbers of hot dinners we serve helps us reduce this cost.

We have been able to maintain schools meals at the current price since 2011. Due to the latest increases in the cost of the service from the LA, the price of a school meal is due to rise in September 2018. Meal prices will be:

- Nursery meal £1.80
- KS2 pupil meal £2.30 (£11.50 per week)

Pupils in Reception, Year 1 and Year 2, will continue to receive free meals under the national universal infant free school meals initiative funded by the Government.
