SUPPORT WITH SAFEGUARDING IN SCHOOL

We continually review procedures in school to ensure we do all we can to keep pupils safe, and appreciate your support with this.

- Please note that staff are in the playground at Reeth from 8:45pm each day to supervise the children before school.
- Pupils are informed that they should not use the silver coloured door release button at Reeth site. Please help to reinforce this message, with the button used by adults only.
- There is a signing in and out record in each school reception area for pupils arriving at, or departing from, school outside usual start and end of day times. We ask that parents of Early Years pupils call at the main reception/office to complete this record when bringing or collecting pupils at times other than their child's usual session times.

ENTERPRISE PROJECT

ADVERSE WEATHER PROCEDURES



In preparation for the possibility of adverse weather conditions, we have taken the precaution of ensuring that our procedures have been checked, updated and made available on our website. The key points to be aware of are:

- Our first line of communication about school closure and school transport in adverse weather is our text messaging service and our website, www.reethandgunnerside.org.uk. The website will be updated by 07:45 each day when conditions are poor. If you don't have internet access or a mobile signal for the text-message service, please let us know. Also, do update the office if you have made any changes to your contact numbers.
- If a school needs to close during the day, we will contact you by telephone.

The most important priority of all is your child's safety. We are not always best placed in school to know what weather conditions are like where you live. If you decide that the roads are unsafe please keep your child at home and inform us by telephone.
