FABRIC OF PLACE – FAMILY WORKSHOPS AND ARTIST TALK

Mountain Biking – additional information

The cycling sessions were a real success last year, with some great feedback from pupils and their parents. We will begin with confidence building skills sessions based in the school grounds, before venturing into the local area, both on and off-road. Pupils taking part in these sessions will be transported from Reeth to Gunnerside where the sessions will be based. Pupils need to be collected from Gunnerside School at 5pm.

School will provide bikes, helmets and gloves.

Pupils will need: PE kit, waterproof jacket, trainers with good grip, rucksack, water bottle and snack.

Lunchtime clubs

We will also continue to offer lunchtime activities at both schools: library sessions, run kindly by our parent volunteers on Mondays (Reeth) and Tuesdays (Gunnerside), art club with Mrs Levell for Reception and KS1, and ukulele club for KS2.

HYGIENE REMINDER

There have been several cases of sickness and infections this term. To minimise pupil illness please be mindful of the following guidelines:

- If a pupil has had sickness and/or diarrhoea they must remain off school for 48 hours from the last episode of illness.
- Please carry out checks for head lice on a regular basis as a preventative measure. Where you need to carry out treatment, it is advised that the whole family is treated and then checked after 2 weeks with a further treatment applied if needed. - Regular hand washing helps stop the spread of germs, particularly before eating meals and after using the toilet. A 20 second scrub/lather is recommended before rinsing – about the time taken to hum 'Happy Birthday' twice.
