Dear Parents,

The last few weeks have seen a number of successes and developments. Firstly, our school has been awarded Artsmark status. The award is Arts Council England's flagship programme to enable schools and other organisations to evaluate, strengthen and celebrate their arts and cultural provision. Our schools were visited by a member of the Artsmark team, who considered the work completed by pupils over the last two years, spoke to a group of children and also to members of the Governing Body. Well done and thank you to all pupils, staff and especially Mrs Walker who coordinates art for our schools.

Over the half term holiday one of our classrooms at Gunnerside School was refurbished. It was great to see the children's faces as they saw the improved layout, space and decoration.

After the half term break we introduced a new behaviour reward scheme, for all classes including nursery. Each pupil has a booklet to record good behaviour stamps. When they have collected 20 they will receive a bronze certificate in assembly. After collecting a further 20, a silver certificate will be awarded and finally, after collecting 60 stamps in total, pupils will receive a gold certificate and a book of their choice. We are already impressed by the children's response to the scheme and look forward to the first bronze certificate!

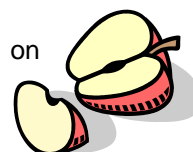


FREE MILK FOR CHILDREN UNDER 5 YEARS
