### CHRISTINGLE SERVICE



Our annual Christingle Service is being held on **Friday 16<sup>th</sup> December at St. Andrew's Church, Grinton, starting at 1.30pm.** This will be a shared event with Arkengarthdale School. Parents, friends and relatives are very welcome to join us for the service. We expect the service to finish by 2pm. **Parents are asked to take their child(ren) home directly after the service and make the most of an early start to the Christmas holiday!** We are hoping that everyone will be able to meet this request, or that you will be able to ask a friend or relative to collect your child for you. Please let us know on the attached reply slip if this is not the case. Transport to the church for pupils from both sites will be arranged by the school. Please complete and return the attached reply slip giving permission for child(ren) to attend the service and indicating travel/collection arrangements afterwards.

We would like to ask for a £1 donation per child to cover the cost of making the Christingle oranges. Please send this to school using the reply slip, or feel free to pop into the office. Any remaining funds will be sent as a donation to the Children's Society. Envelopes to collect donations from family or friends for the Children's Society will be sent home with pupils next week. Please return these envelopes to school by Wednesday 14<sup>th</sup> December. There will also be a collection plate in aid of the Children's Society at the service.

To encourage safety around lit candles, all pupils with long hair should come to school with their hair tied back. Our younger pupils will be using glow sticks in their Christingle oranges. At the end of the service all pupils will return to their seats, for staff to supervise a safe handover from the pews to parents.

### Nursery aged pupils

Pupils will make Christingle oranges on the morning of the Christingle service. A pack of items will be provided to pupils who don't attend on Friday mornings so that they can make their Christingle at

home. Pupils who usually attend on Friday afternoons will travel by bus to the Church and will be supervised by school staff during the service. Nursery aged pupils who don't normally attend on Friday afternoons are welcome to join us along with their accompanying adult(s).

### SCHOOL ACTIVITY CLUBS

We are delighted with pupil and parent response to the after-school activity sessions that we offer. They are a great opportunity for pupils of all ages to work together and enjoy some extra curricular activities. Pupils are welcome to sign up for as many of these as they wish.
